French Hospital Medical Center and San Luis Diagnostic Center Acquire the General Electric 3D Breast Tomosynthesis

The most innovative mammography technology available provides a clearer, more accurate view for breast exams

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA – November 12, 2015 – French Hospital Medical Center (FHMC), a member of the Dignity Health system that locally also includes Arroyo Grande Community Hospital and Marian Regional Medical Center, is proud to announce the purchase of two new and technologically advanced GE SenoClaire 3D Breast Tomosynthesis (DBT) mammography imaging machines. The new mammography machine has been installed at French Hospital's outpatient imaging center, San Luis Diagnostic Center, and is currently being installed at French Hospital. The San Luis Diagnostic Center began breast tomosynthesis scans on Monday, November 9, 2015. These new machines are due to the generosity of community donors whose donations totaled \$210,000 to the French Hospital Foundation.

GE's SenoClaire Breast Tomosynthesis is a three-dimensional imaging technology that uses a low-dose short X-ray sweep around the compressed breast. The SenoClaire detector delivers high quality digital imagery at low dose that delivers greater accuracy in finding size, shape, and location of any breast irregularities. In addition to standard digital mammography scanning, breast tomosynthesis takes multiple images of the entire breast which allows our specialized radiologists to see through layers of breast tissue and examine all areas from all viewpoints.

"Due to its low dose and non-inferior clinical accuracy, the GE SenoClaire has the potential to replace digital mammography exams in screening to detect breast cancer," explains Dr. Fred Vernacchia, San Luis Diagnostic Center Medical Director. "It's an excellent balance of precision and performance, so you can be confident that its detector delivers high quality digital imagery at low dose for visualizing microcalcifications without binning, a process that regroups pixels for faster readout speeds and improved signal-to-noise ratios."
